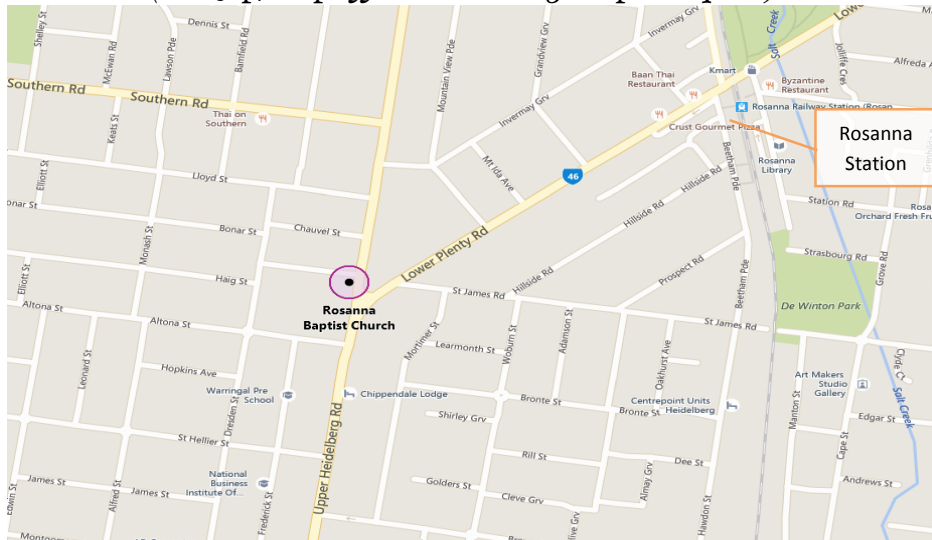


## Venue Information
